- ✓ will test the applications and give us feedback.

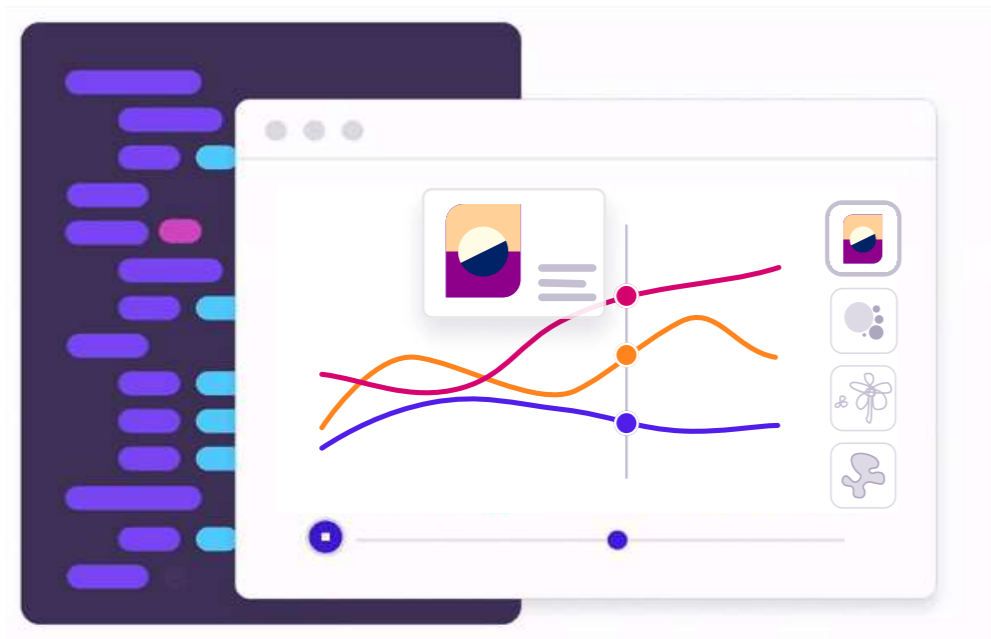

**The project will only be implemented if the application is approved for EU funding. Additional information about the partner organization will have to be provided for the application.*

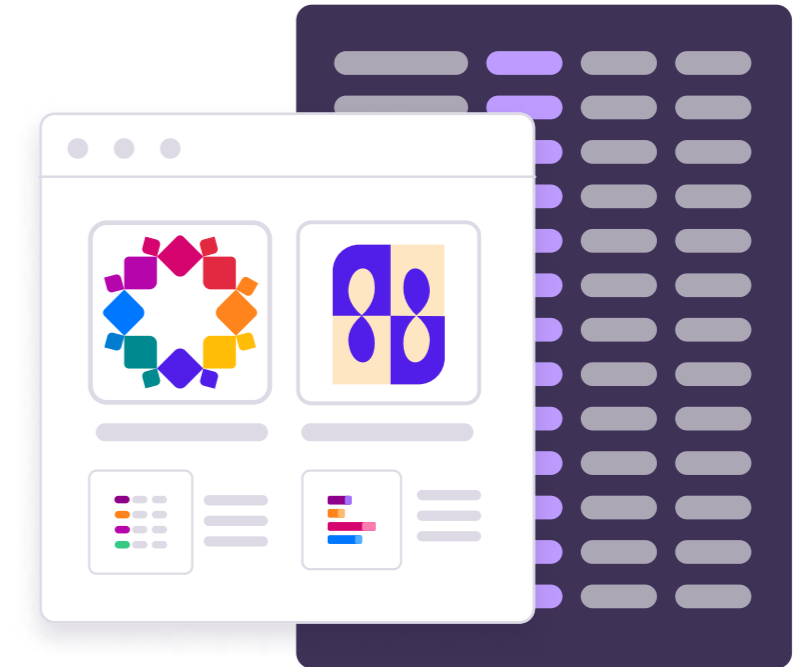
